

Camp Mosaic 2024

1. What is Camp Mosaic?

Camp Mosaic is a non-residential camp program for primary school youth. Mosaic is about lifelong relationships, built piece by piece, through meaningful conversations and interactions — a place where participants create bonds with others and find themselves. What is perhaps most remarkable is that the camp is run mostly by youth. At a time in their lives when young people are used to hearing that they aren't old enough, mature enough, experienced enough, or empathetic enough to be leaders, Camp Mosaic tells them that they are. Camp Mosaic empowers youth and, through encouragement, accountability, and a guiding hand develops current and future leaders of the Jamat.

2. What are the philosophies that guide Camp Mosaic?

- Unleash human potential
- Break boundaries
- Create an environment where the sum of the whole is greater than the individual parts
- Create a Camp Mosaic family
- Make a long-term impact on Participants
- Maintain a Participant-centred approach

3. What are the objectives of Camp Mosaic?

- Provide a fun-filled, supportive, and nurturing environment where Isma'ili Muslim youth can interact with their peers
 - Enhance self-esteem, self-reliance, self-confidence and critical thinking skills
 - Encourage a physically, emotionally and mentally healthy and balanced lifestyle
 - Encourage expression and creativity
 - Encourage sporting excellence by providing exposure to professional sporting and encourage ethics of good sportsmanship including teamwork, communication, leadership and resilience
 - Develop Participants' ability to apply the ethics and values of Islam in everyday life
 - Help Participants develop skills by exposing them to new activities
 - Strengthen parent-child relationships by providing meaningful parental engagement at camp
 - Provide counsellors an opportunity to be young leaders, teachers and positive role models to the younger youth

4. Who can attend Camp Mosaic?

Isma'ili Muslim youth from ANZ are encouraged to attend Camp Mosaic 2024!

- Adelaide | Brisbane | Perth- Students in school grades 1-6 (as of 2024) are welcome to register.
- Auckland Students in school grades 2-7 (as of 2024) are welcome to register.
- Melbourne | Sydney Students in school grades 4-6 (as of 2024) are welcome to register.

Please note, there has been a slight change to the range of students eligible to register in certain cities. The reason for this is for the increased quantity of participants and to keep the same quality of camp we have decide to do alternate years for these school grades.

5. When is Camp Mosaic?

On the last day of camp, all parents are invited to attend the **Endings Session.** This will be followed by afternoon tea, after which Parents may take participants home.

6. Where will Camp Mosaic be held?

Camp Mosaic in 2024 will be held in Adelaide, Auckland, Brisbane, Melbourne, Sydney and Perth. There will be some travel required to an outside venue, but transport for this will be arranged by the Local Implementation Team.

7. How much does Camp Mosaic cost?

Camp costs vary depending on the city: \$45 for a two-day camp and \$20 for a one-day camp. This fee supports the expenses for supplies, transportation, and meals, ensuring participants stay well-nourished and engaged. Rest assured; your request will be kept confidential.

8. Who are Counsellors?

Counsellors are youth aged between 18 and 30 years who will be present at Camp Mosaic to assist Participants on their journey throughout the camp. They will act as mentors, role models, and friends, facilitating the Participants' experiences and ensuring they have a memorable and enriching time at camp.

9. What kind of health and safety measures will be taken during Camp Mosaic?

Trained medical staff will always be on-site. The registration forms require details of any existing medical conditions and allergies that participants may have, which must be provided when completing the forms. Participants will have access to water and sunscreen throughout the camp, and they will be encouraged to wear hats during outdoor activities.

10. What if I have prescribed medication?

Any prescribed medications must be provided at registration, along with detailed dosage instructions. All medications will be administered by a trained medical professional.

The Camp will have zero tolerance on all drugs, cigarettes, and alcohol.
