

GAME ON FAQs

Q1. What is Game On?

A: Game On is a Sydney based local sports tournament under the umbrella of AKYSB. The purpose of the program is to create a fun and active sports environment in a social setting.

Q2. When is Game On?

A: Game On will be held on 5th of October 2024.

Q3. Where is Game On being held?

A: Game On is being held at Hills Indoor Sports + Batting Centre. Address is 20 Distribution Pl, Seven Hills NSW 2147.

Q4. What sports are being offered in Game On?

A: Game On offers Indoor Cricket and Netball sports only.

Q5. What are the subcategories for each of the sports offered?

A: Following are the categories within each sport offered:

Cricket	Netball
Youth Mixed – Over 11 but under 18	Youth Mixed – Over 11 but under 18
Adults – 18+ Women	Adults – 18+ Women
Adults – 18+ Men	Adults – 18+ Mixed

Q6. How many sports can I select in each category / sport?

A: Only one sport and sub-categories can be selected

Q7. How much will it cost me and my family to attend this event?

A: Game On registration will be as follows:

- Adult Athletes fees (18+) \$30
- Child Athletes fees (>11 but <18) \$15
- Spectators' fees \$10 (except child under 5)

Please note: If you have not paid the registration fee by the close of registration for Game On, your registration will be forfeited, and you will not be able to compete.

Q8. Will food and refreshments be provided at Game On?

A: Light refreshments will be provided at the venues. There are also other paid options available at the venue.

Q9. Who can compete in Game On?

A: The criteria to compete at Game On is as follows:

- Shia Imami Ismaili Muslims including partners and children of multi-faith Ismaili Families can participate as Athletes, Volunteers or Spectators.

The age groups (based on the date of birth specified below) for athletes at Game On will be as follows:

Over 11 but Under 18	18+/Open
Born on or between 01/08/2006 – 31/07/2013	Born on or before 01/08/2006

Please Note: In all stances athletes date of birth will be used to determine the age group as per the above table.

Q10. For Under 18 athletes, can I compete in a higher age group?

A: No, you cannot compete in 18+/Open category if you are under 18

Registrations opens on 2nd August 2024 and closes on 24th August 2024

Q12. Can I register as a family including spectators?

A: Each athlete will have to register individually. Spectators may register individually or as a family.

Q13. What is the minimum and maximum number of team members for each team sport?

A: The minimum and maximum number of team members per sport are as follows:

Sport	Minimum team members	Maximum team members
Cricket	8	10
Netball	7	9

Q14. Can I form my own team, or will you find me one?

A: For youth (Under 11-8), Game On will create a team to ensure fair and equitable distribution of the kids in the various date range.

For Adults (18+), we would prefer individuals to make up their own team and register. However, if you cannot find a team, we will try and form a team of individuals who couldn't make it together.

Please note: In an event that we are unable to find you a team, you cannot participate in the tournament and we will refund you the fees.

Q15. Can I or my team member(s) be disqualified from a sport or the tournament?

A: Yes, you and/or you and your team member(s) can be disqualified for example by falsifying registration details, breaking policies regarding substance abuse, lack of sportsmanship, etc. Any form of breaking the code of conduct could result in penalties, suspension or disqualification.

The Game On Conflict Resolution Team's decision on any policies is final and effective immediately.

Q17. What if someone drops out of my team? Can updates be made to the team roster?

A: Please refer to the below:

A team can add team members for Game On, provided:

- It does not exceed the maximum team size (refer question 13);
- The new team member is not already part of another team;
- The new team member has completed registration and paid their registration fee

Q18. Does my entire team need to be at Game On including substitutes?

A: Yes, the expectation will be that all registered and paid athletes in your team are in attendance during Game On including any team members that are substitutes and might not compete on the day as they are still part of your team.

Q19. Do I need to bring my own equipment to compete at Game On?

A: Yes, all athletes are expected to bring their own personal equipment to compete at Game On. In terms of equipment, we will be providing ball & bibs for Netball game and Cricket ball and Stumps for Indoor Cricket. If you have any issues or aren't able to organise equipment for any reason, please contact Game On team at the earliest opportunity and no later than 2 weeks before the tournament.

Q20. Are there going to be any activities for spectators at Game On?

A: No.
