

GAME ON 2025 FAQs

Q1. What is Game On?

A: Game On is a Sydney based local sports tournament under the umbrella of AKYSB. The purpose of the program is to create a fun and active sports environment in a social setting.

Q2. When is Game On?

A: Game On will be held on Sunday 1st June at PlayPoint Seven Hills.

Q3. Where is Game On being held?

A: Game On is being held at PlayPoint Seven Hills. Address is 2/6 Boden Rd, Seven Hills NSW 2147

Q4. What sports are being offered in Game On?

A: Game On 2025 offers Badminton only.

Q5. What are the subcategories for each of the sports offered?

A: Following are the categories within the sport offered:

18+	U18
Women's Singles	Girls (Ages 10-14) Singles
Women's Doubles	Boys (Ages 10-14) Singles
Men's Singles	Girls (Ages 15-18) Singles
Men's Doubles	Girls (Ages 15-18) Doubles
Mixed Doubles	Boys (Ages 15-18) Singles
	Boys (Ages 15-18) Doubles

Q6. How many categories can I select in this sport?

A: For all **18+** athletes, **two categories** are on offer:

Category 1: Singles **OR** Doubles

Category 2: Mixed Doubles

For all **U18** athletes only **one/ a single category** is allowed at this stage.

Q7. How much will it cost me and my family to attend this event?

A: Game On registration will be as follows:

18+ Athletes: \$25

Under 18 Athletes: \$15

Spectators: \$10

Please note: If you have not paid the registration fee by the close of registration for Game On, your registration will be forfeited, and you will not be able to compete. As there are limited spots, please complete your full registration including fees to secure your spot.

Q8. Will food and refreshments be provided at Game On?

A: Light refreshments and sandwiches will be available at the venue.

Q9. Who can compete in Game On?

A: The criteria to compete at Game On is as follows:

- Shia Imami Ismaili Muslims including partners and children of multi-faith Ismaili Families can participate as Athletes, Volunteers or Spectators.

Please Note: In all instances athletes' date of birth will be used to determine the age group. The cut of DOB for the 10-14 age category will be 31/05/2015

Q10. For Under 18 athletes, can I compete in a higher age group?

A: No, you cannot compete in 18+/Open category if you are under 18

Q11. How do I register for Game On?

Q12. Can I register as a family including spectators?

A: Each athlete will have to register individually. Spectators may register individually or as a family.

Q14. Can I form my own team for doubles, or will you find me one?

A: For all athletes, we would prefer individuals to find their own doubles/mixed doubles partner and register. However, if you cannot find a team, we will try and make it for you if there are also other individuals who have registered in a similar position.

Please note: In an event that we are unable to find you a doubles/mixed doubles partner, you cannot participate in the tournament, and we will refund you the fees. If we are

successful in allocating a partner for you, please keep in mind that no preference for partners will be considered.

Q15. Can I or my team member(s) be disqualified from a sport or the tournament?

A: Yes, you and/or you and your team member(s) can be disqualified for example by falsifying registration details, breaking policies regarding substance abuse, lack of sportsmanship, etc. Any form of breaking the code of conduct could result in penalties, suspension or disqualification.

The Game On Conflict Resolution Team's decision on any policies is final and effective immediately.

Q17. What if someone drops out of my doubles/mixed doubles team?

An individual can elect a new doubles partner for Game On, provided:

- The doubles partner is not already part of another team;
- The new partner has completed registration and paid their registration fee

Q18. Do I need to bring my own equipment to compete at Game On?

A: Yes, all athletes are expected to bring their own personal equipment to compete at Game On. If you have any issues or aren't able to organise equipment for any reason, please contact Game On team at the earliest opportunity and no later than 2 weeks before the tournament.
